

#### **Instructional Expenses**

Sectional coaches and co-curricular rehearsals, specialist services (for commissioning new composition work), instrument maintenance & repairs, continuing education and professional affiliation, and classroom/office supplies.

#### **Concert, Festivals & Competitions Expenses**

Mechanical licensing to play copyrighted compositions, graphic work, printing, decorations, registration and transportation fees for festivals, and adjudication fees for competitions.

#### Other Events & Banquet Expenses

Student social and mentorship events, orchestra family events, and annual banquet expenses for entertainment, senior class recognition, awards and subsidized banquet fees, and decorations and supplies.

#### **Program Support & Development Expenses**

Website administration expenses, communications online services and brochure fees, online archiving fees, program mentoring and recruiting fees, and advocacy and consulting fees.
